Our new flagship is now under construction at the famous yards of "Cantieri Riuniti dell'Adriatico" in Monfalcone. near Trieste.


As yet uningmed this ship of advanced structural design will be ready for cruising and transatlantic service in the fall of 1963. Her ultra-modern design will be accentuated by a raked funnel aft and

an aluminum superstructure. The new super-liner will be operated between Canada and the Channel ports to augment our Canadian service now being maintained by our present flagship "Homeric". She will be the largest passenger ship ever to pavigate the St. Lawrence from and to Montreal, Inwinter she will be operated on cruises from New York to the Caribbean one of the largest vessels ever to be employed in that trade.
